General rules..

CASH ONLY

NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED.

All parents/guardians of exhibitors must sign a release before competing.

Times will be announced after each run.

Backup clock will be used.

Closed gate unless otherwise specified.

Any deviation from the posted pattern will result in a NO-TIME.

Crossing final time line before pattern is finished will result in a NO-TIME.

Knocked down poles or barrels will result in 5 second penalty per knock down to the final time.

If clock fails during a run, a rerun will be given at the end of that heat.

Tractor drag every 10 horses, depending on number of entries.

Show management reserves the right to make amendments or adjustments, combine or cancel classes due to lack of entrants.

Pole bending: will follow AQHA pattern

Cloverleaf barrels: will follow AQHA pattern

Straights: weave barrels up and back

Goat ribbon run: exhibitor will ride horse to a safe distance from tethered goat, jump off horse, grab ribbon off goat, and run on foot across time line. There will a handler to hold horse for those that ask for it.

Flags: exhibitor will run to and around barrel, grabbing flag, and return to starting point. If exhibitor circles barrel or crosses their path at any time, they will receive a NO-TIME. (Pattern is like a horseshoe or U around barrel).
